## School Improvement - A focus on ICT from our Acting Assistant Principal James Cracknell

Over the school holidays we have continued to upgrade some of the technology around our school. This included finishing off the replacement of our old projector screens and interactive boards with 75 inch touch screen displays. These have been installed into Room 11 - 16 (Current Year 1 and Year 6 classrooms) and into our second Music Room. These devices provide teachers with an essential resource to ensure their teaching programs are as engaging as possible. It also ensures that all students can see and hear the content being delivered in the classrooms.

We have also had our network upgraded to help increase the speed that data can be transferred around our school.

This has also enabled us to have the potential to expand our wireless network and have greater capacity for more devices to be connected in our classrooms.










## **School Photographs**


