TOY LIBRARY

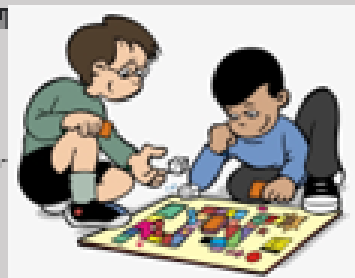
TheirCare toy library is back in full swing and is providing a range of giant games for the children!
